

IATS Educator of the Year

Eligibility: A member of IATS who has shown outstanding abilities in educating at high school, collegiate, or corporate level:

1. Athletic Training Students
2. Athletes/Patients
3. Community
4. Allied Health Care Professionals
5. Peers in Athletic Training

- Must be a member of NATA
- Must be a member of IATS
- Must be Licensed in State of Iowa
- Must have demonstrated excellence in education
- Nomination must be made by an IATS Member

Criteria: The nominator is responsible for supplying the Awards Committee with the following information:

1. Nominees address, phone number, e-mail address, place of employment
2. Nominees proof of NATA affiliation, IATS membership, State Licensure
3. Nominators address, phone number, e-mail address
4. Two Letters of nomination as to why they feel the nominee is deserving of the award
5. Submission of nominee's Resume/ CV
6. Submission of evidence of instructional effectiveness. Possible examples of this evidence include: student evaluations from courses taught, peer evaluations of instruction for the nominee, attendee evaluations of the nominee's conference presentations, a letter from a recipient of the nominees instruction. Nominees only need to submit 1 of these items

Selection: The Awards Committee will review applications and chose best candidate and the forward selection to IATS President for approval.
