

IATS Hall of Honor Application

Eligibility: A member of the NATA and IATS who is in good standing, left the profession in good standing, or has retired.

Must also have at least 20 years of service as an ATC

Must be State of Iowa Licensed

Criteria: Three levels are needed to be met for consideration

Years of Service in Athletic Training

- Years in the profession
- Awards/honors

Professional Involvement in Athletic Training

- Contributions to IATS, MAATA, NATA

Community, job related regional and state related contributions

- Recognition for exceptional attention to healthcare; place of employment
- Promoting the athletic training profession

Nomination applications for IATS Hall of Honor should include the following:

- 1.) Contact information (name, email, phone number) for Nominee and Nominator
- 2.) 2 letters of nomination outlining nominees exceptional service and contributions to athletic training
- 3.) Nominees CV/Resume

Selection: The Awards Committee will review applications and chose best candidate and then forward selection to IATS President for approval.
